




Meet Teacher Zelmi Grade 3



Helping Your Child Succeed: Study Tips for Parents

- 1. Create a Study-Friendly Environment: Set up a quiet, well-lit area free from distractions where your child can focus. A consistent study space helps children mentally prepare to learn
- 2. Establish a Routine: Consistency builds good habits. Set a regular time each day for homework and studying to make it part of your child's daily schedule.
- 3. Encourage Breaks: Help your child avoid burnout by taking short breaks during study sessions. A 5-10 minute break every 30-45 minutes can boost focus and retention.
- 4. Be Involved, Not Overbearing: Ask open-ended questions about what they're learning, and encourage them to explain it to you. This reinforces their understanding without you needing to "teach" them.
- 5. Stay Positive and Supportive: Celebrate effort, not just grades. Praise your child's hard work and perseverance, which builds confidence and motivation.
- 6. Monitor and Limit Screen Time: Balance is key. Ensure screens aren't interfering with homework or sleep, and encourage offline activities that support learning.
- 7. Communicate with Teachers: Stay in touch with your child's teachers. Understanding classroom expectations helps you better support learning at home.
